Curriculum

Our STREAMM+ Integrated Curriculum is designed to prepare students to succeed at the university level as well as to develop leaders who can meet demands of the 21st century. STREAMM stands for: science, technology, religion, arts, math and medicine. 'Plus' means that enhanced AP, College in High School (CHS) and topic specific electives are offered as individual courses with an in-depth focus. The cross-curricular focus creates cohesive, holistic, education that provides an opportunity for students to come to a greater depth of understanding and to maximize retention of important concepts.

Graduation Requirements

Freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors are required to take 7 credits per academic year. All students must be full time. 1 credit = 1 academic year.
